## Ignite the Faith Campaign Update

The Ignite the Faith Campaign to secure donations for the renovation and remodeling of St. Mary's Parish and St. Mary School has closed. The pledge goal of \$3,500,000 was met and exceeded by \$5,900. While some pledges remain unpaid, 99.5% of donors completed their pledge payments. This exceeds industry averages by nearly 10%.

To date, pledged and unpledged contributions total \$3,531,912. Designated contributions will continue to be received into the Ignite the Faith Campaign fund.

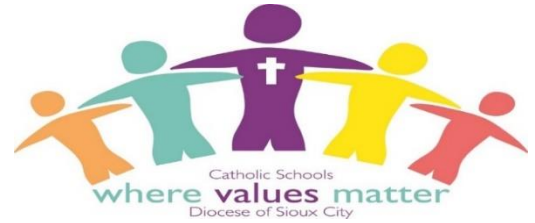
