The pledge goal of \$3,500,000 was met and exceeded by \$5,900. While some pledges remain unpaid, 99.5% of donors completed their pledge payments. This exceeds industry averages by nearly 10%.

To date, pledged and unpledged contributions total \$3,531,912. Designated contributions will continue to be received into the Ignite the Faith Campaign fund.




