Grain donations are being accepted **NOW** for the 2024 Monsignor Lafferty Tuition Foundation (MLTF). Take advantage of a 75% state of Iowa tax credit relative to the value of your grain donation.



Generally, donors avoid recognizing the income from the sale of donated grain while also receiving the benefit of 75% in state of Iowa tax credits relative to the value of the grain at the time of the gift. (Check with your tax advisor regarding your situation.)

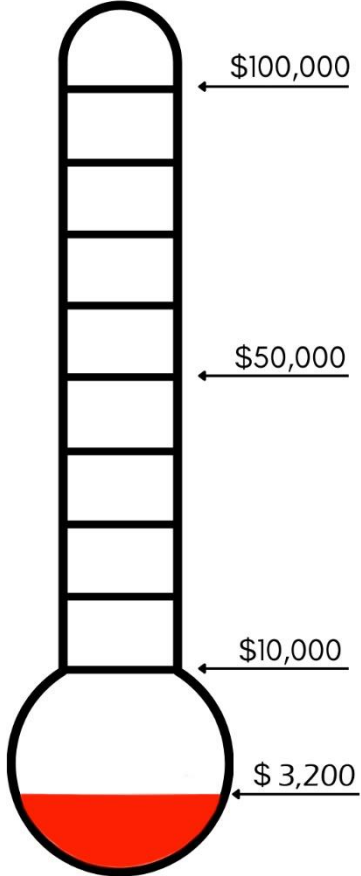
How do I gift grain to MLTF?

Before or at the time of delivering the grain to your local elevator, obtain and complete a Transfer of Ownership form available at www.scdiocese.org/mltf.

Forward the Transfer of Ownership form, along with the MLTF gift form (available at www.scdiocese.org/mltf) to Jessica Wilcox at jessicaw@scdiocese.org. Contact Jessica at (712) 233-7565.

After the transfer, MLTF owns the grain, and MLTF must be the entity to sell the grain at market value. (The donor cannot initiate the sale.)
